Subject: Slow Streets 2.0 – Letter of Intent – HPB25-0678

Dear Mr. Michael Belush,

The City of Miami Beach Transportation & Mobility Department is seeking Historic Preservation Board review and approval of the proposed vertical delineation/path dividers and painted curb extension elements of the Slow Streets 2.0 project in the Flamingo Park Neighborhood, which is implementing the first ever parking-protected, two-way cycle-track in the City of Miami Beach, on Jefferson Avenue between 6 Street and 11 Street. Vertical delineation/path dividers via K71 bollards and painted curb extensions are also proposed on 13 Street, between Meridian Avenue and Washington Avenue.

The purpose of both the vertical delineation and the painted curb extensions is to increase pedestrian safety, slow speeding motor vehicles, and enhance the streetscape and livability of two residential streets in the City of Miami Beach.

Please note that the K71 bollards, aesthetically, are much more attractive than the narrow, plastic 'delineators' that currently exist in many locations throughout Miami Beach. The K71 bollards are shorter, wider, and mimic true bollards in their design, such as those you see on Española Way – while still maintaining flexibility if in contact with a motor vehicle. The proposed painted curb extensions will be using a color similar to the 'Miami Beach Red' seen on our sidewalks, using StreetBond SB150 paint designed for roadways and longevity in the color 'Rose Dust.'

The City of Miami Beach Transportation & Mobility Department is seeking Historic Preservation Board approval of the Slow Streets 2.0 project elements for the purpose of beautifying and promoting safety in the Flamingo Park Neighborhood.
